Lettering for the WHS Choral Department requires commitment, responsibility, and hard work. All chorus members qualify for lettering using a merit point system.

Requirements:

To qualify for a letter award, a choral student must:

- Sing in **all** concerts, extra rehearsals, and Georgia Music Educators Association Performance Evaluation (LGPE).
- Exhibit exemplary behavior and attitude.
- Earn at least **100** lettering points-30 of these **must** be earned through fundraising.
 - Fundraising points are Booster Donations and the Raffle.

ALL LETTERING POINTS ARE DUE BY MARCH 29, 2024.

Lettering points are recorded in CHARMS by the class presidents (Men's-Shane R., Varsity Treble- Ellie B./Sareena P., SWE- Kate I. & Kaitlyn S., A Cappella- Makena B.) All 9th grade treble singers will submit their points to Lauren H./Dr. Mann. Please be sure to keep a personal record of your earned points. CHARMS will be updated with fall point submissions in December for you to check and again in February.

Two weeks prior to the End-of-Year Celebration, a list of those students who have earned their letter will be posted online and on the chorus room doors. Students will have one week to verify that all information is correct. Lettering lists are final one week prior to the End-of-Year Celebration – no additional changes will be made.

When Letters are given:

Students receive the Letters during the End-of-Year Celebration at the end of the year.
